Miss Washington's Teen 2025 – Frequently Asked Questions

• Can I participate in Miss Washington's Teen without competing in a local preliminary?

 Yes! Teen contestants can participate at the State level by signing up as an "Open Titleholder" and can then participate in all local events and work in their community as their chosen title until September 30th of the competition year.

• How much does it cost to participate as an Open Titleholder?

- The registration fee is \$600 and includes your official sash and title, a MWATeen t-shirt,
 Pinecone Coronation Day activities and outings, complimentary entrance to all Miss
 Washington preliminary competitions, events and luncheons.
- o If you were named as a runner-up during the 2025 local season, you pay just \$500 for registration.
- You must pay an annual \$39 membership fee to Miss America. A link will be provided after you register for MWATeen.
- A deposit of \$250 will secure your title and entrance to MWATeen 2025!

• Where are Miss Washington's Teen events and competition held?

- o Pinecone Coronation Day and Dessert Dash April 5, 2025, Olympia, WA
- Attend Open/Sweeper Competition (final preliminary to Miss WA) April 6, 2025, Olympia, WA
- Spring Forum May 2-4, 2025, Olympia, WA
- o Miss Washington's Teen Sunday, June 29 Wednesday, July 2, 2025, Olympia, WA

What events am I required to attend?

- You must arrive in Olympia on June 29 and compete on July 1st and 2nd.
- Spring Forum, May 2-4 is also required. It contains workshops and presentations regarding the state competition as well as fun events with the Miss Washington contestants!
- The other events are HIGHLY suggested to attend as those events are covered by your registration fee and are a critical part of preparing you for the state competition. Pinecone Coronation Day is important to connect with your Pinecone Little Sister!

What are the phases of competition?

- Private Interview 30%
- Talent/HerStory 20%
- On-stage Conversation 10%
- Lifestyle & Fitness 20%
- Evening Gown 20%

• What are the competition wardrobe requirements?

 We go into detail during Spring Forum to assist you in choosing the best looks for the phases of competition. We encourage borrowing competition clothes from past contestants and reseller sites in order to save money.

You need:

- Interview outfit
- talent outfit/costume
- required fitness/athletic wear from Rebel Athletics (our official sponsor, top and bottom combined, around \$100)
- Opening production number outfit (our choice, around \$125)
- Second half production number dress (your choice)
- full length evening gown
- nude open toe heels (no tippy tops or platforms over 1.5 inches)

What additional costs are there to be aware of?

- A parent/guardian/adult mentor is required to accompany our Teens during all events. Some events like Spring Forum and MWATeen competition weekend require multi-day stays at the host hotel. The average rate is \$150/night in the spring and \$175/night during State week.
- MWSO does provide some meals during competition week but be prepared to have funds for breakfast and lunch each day.
- Teen titleholders have complimentary entry into all events, but parents/guardians, friends and family will need to pay for tickets to all events. Tickets are generally \$25-35 each. This includes:

 - Open/Sweeper Competition (4/6/25)
 - Spring Forum breakfast/keynote speaker (5/3/25)
 - Spring Forum Lip Sync competition (5/3/25)

 - MWATeen Preliminary Competition (7/1/25)
 - MWATeen Final Night Competition (7/2/25)
